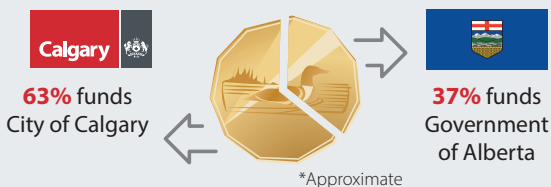

Where your residential tax dollars go*



Changes for a typical single-family home (assessed at \$697,000) in 2025:

+\$217 → The Provincial budget

We collect property tax on behalf of the province. Provincial property tax increased **15.6%** for residential customers. Over \$1 billion will go to the province in 2025.

+\$134 → The City budget and property assessment

City property tax increased **5.3%** for the typical home to deliver City services, support businesses, and because of property values changes.

In total, The City will collect \$2.4 billion from all properties in 2025 to deliver City services.
